

JR. FAIR RABBIT ENTRY PROCEDURE

1. Each member lists all rabbits on entry form that will be shown in Jr. Fair classes at the Darke County Fair. Use a separate line for each rabbit. USE SEPARATE ENTRY BLANK FOR EACH BREED AND MEAT PEN ENTRIES. Rabbits must be pedigreed.
 2. Classes should be indicated as follows: SENIOR
6-8
JUNIOR
- NOTE: No animal 6 months of age or over is eligible to show in junior classes. Single meat rabbits cannot be part of pen of 3.
3. Meat rabbits should be entered on appropriate section of entry form. Meat entries - all breeds - entries limited to one (1) pen of three and two (2) singles per exhibitor. Rabbits can be divided according to class at time of weigh-in on the first Friday of the Fair. We must have ear numbers at the time of entry.
 4. All rabbits, including market rabbits, must be permanently tattooed in their left ear.
 5. Project animals ONLY are to be exhibited in Jr. Fair classes at the Darke County Fair. There will be no selling of rabbits during the Jr. Fair Rabbit Show.
 6. Rabbits that are entered in the Jr. Fair show may be sold but not released until Thursday afternoon, after the Showman of Showmen Contest.
 7. No rabbits are to be carried in after 9:00pm Friday or at any time on Saturday during the Jr. Fair show.
 8. This entry is for Jr. Fair classes only. Exhibitors wanting to show in open class must make those entries with the Secretary's Office on the Fairgrounds on or before July 17th.
