Fair:

Poles for jumps: There was discussion about painting the poles. Amy will evaluate the current condition of the paint / poles and we will schedule a date/ time to paint at the next meeting. Kelly offered to allow us to paint them in their climate controlled shop.

Skillathon - The skillathon is on July 16th, 2020. Participants must arrive between 4pm-7pm to start the test. Amy passed out the Skillathon info sheet, which was reviewed, changes were made, and Amy will bring these to the next meeting.

Show - There was discussion about shows. It was decided to move the camp show contesting classes to Friday, June 12th, to start at 5pm. The camp committee will discuss the end time of camp on Friday. Then the showmanship/ performance classes will start at 9am on Saturday, June 13th. Our mid-summer show will no longer be a MVHSA show and will instead be a 4-H show with show clothes required. This will be on Saturday, July 18th.
