Dear Friend in 4-H,

IMPORTANT REMINDER: EVERY CHILD in 4-H is required to complete a project book for every project they take on an annual basis. This has always been 4-H policy and any club not following this policy is in violation. Each club's enrollment packet for the year includes a project book order form – use it to order books for your club. Or, families may come to the Extension Office and purchase books individually.

Reminder: ALL Darke County 4-H Volunteers must attend one of the mandatory update meetings in order to retain volunteer status for 2018. Thirteen dates remain. 1. **Rabbit, Cavy and Equipment Auction:** Lima Rabbit Breeders Association cordially invites you to this event on April 14, 2018 at the Allen County Fairgrounds in Lima, OH. Lima RBA also hosts a rabbit clinic that includes quality assurance presented by 4-H advisers from Allen County, Other topics for the clinic include showmanship, first aid and health, and selecting meat pens along with some hands on activities.

They do ask that there be a 4-H or agricultural theme to the centerpiece, and they would like members to send an index card with a short explanation of their work. His aide will be collecting the centerpieces on Friday, March 2nd.
There is no limit on the amount of entries per county. Members can either work together on centerpieces, or individually.
Farm Forum Centerpiece Project
- Can be 2 or 3 dimensional, No larger than 2 cubic feet
 - Should be 4-H or Agricultural theme
 - Include index card explaining the centerpiece
 - Can be produced by groups or individual students
 - Submissions will be picked up at County Extension Offices on Friday, March 2nd and returned during the following week
- Please let the Extension Office know if you are interested in submitting a centerpiece.
