(You must exhibit poultry at the 2023 Darke County Fair to be eligible.) This includes 4 year universities/colleges, 2 year colleges and trade/technical schools. The scholarship will be awarded after the completion of the first semester of post-secondary education. Money will be sent directly to post-secondary institution. The baskets items sold at the 2023 Darke County Junior Poultry Sale will help fund this scholarship opportunity. It is the responsibility of the scholarship recipient to send transcript to Darke Jr Fair Poultry Committee Treasurer.
