The clock is ticking! Time to submit your 4-H enrollments. If you have not reenrolled yourself as a volunteer, please do so by now. Encourage your 4-H families to finish their enrollments, too!

News You Can Use – 4-H:

1. **2023 Enrollment: 4-H Online** is open and accepting enrollments for 2023. Volunteers and members can login and reenroll at any time. Volunteers who have to complete a background check should enroll as soon as possible. That way when background check results are received by OSU-HR, they can connect the results of your background check to your 4-H Online profile. You should login using your family email and password. If you have forgotten your password, use the Forgot Password link. If you are unsure of your family email, or it needs changed, contact our office. 2. **Cloverbud Enrollment** – there is only one number in the database this year for enrolling Cloverbuds. Please instruct your families to select 710GPM when enrolling their Cloverbud for 2023.
3. First ever **Buckeye Young Shepherds' Expo**: Exciting, hands-on sessions around a variety of sheep and lamb topics. Complete your Quality Assurance requirements, take a look at a real lamb carcass and the cuts of meat, work on your ear tagging/tail docking/injection skills, and learn about careers in the livestock industry. Plus, visit with old friends and make new ones! The cost is \$15 for youth and adults, which includes lunch. Youth participants receive a FREE t-shirt.
