**Quality Assurance test out option::** QA tests can be scheduled at the Extension Office on Friday, April 19 at 10am or 2pm. Contact our office to preregister. If a member would like to attempt the test-out but isn't available on April 19, contact our office to schedule an alternative date.

Here's what's happening:

1. **Raise Your Hand Campaign:** National 4-H is conducting the Raise Your Hand campaign from April 1 until May 15. Go online to raise your and vote for Ohio. Ohio has won \$20,000 for the past two years. Help us earn a three-peat! A portion of the \$20,000 is returned to the Ohio counties that have the most people vote.
2. **Cloverbud Volunteer Training:** A training for new Cloverbud Volunteers is scheduled for Tuesday, April 16, 7pm, Extension Office. Any current 4-H Volunteer who is interested in becoming a Cloverbud Volunteer should attend. Please contact our office to register.

heifers must be owned by May 1 and will be verified by their 15 digit 840 RFID tag number and DNA submission to the Ohio State Fair by May 1, 2019. Must be born after January 1, 2018, and make entries into the state fair by June 1. DNA kits may be requested by email only from Stacey French, [s.french@expo.ohio.gov](mailto:s.french@expo.ohio.gov) and must be submitted to Stacey French, Agriculture Department - Crossbred Heifer DNA, 717 East 17<sup>th</sup> Avenue, Columbus OH 43211, by May 1. If anyone wants to pick up and/or drop off DNA kit, contact Stacey French by email first, stating request, and when they want to come and pick up and/or drop off.

6. Camp this summer at the Nationwide & Ohio Farm Bureau 4-H Center. **4-H Camp Tech** is from June 5-7 for youth entering grades 6, 7 and 8. You'll explore all things tech-y from programming with Google to virtual reality to robotics and more! Details at <http://go.osu.edu/CampTech>.
7. Learn about life in another culture and learn about making a difference at **4-H Global AgriCULTURE Camp**, from June 10-14. Youth entering grades 8, 9 and 10 will spend three days at OSU discovering how agriculture can impact global food issues, then travel to Howell, Michigan for an over experience at the Heifer Global Village.
