1. Open to all JR. Fair exhibitors showing in Darke County who have shown swine 3 out of the last 4 years and who are showing swine the current year.
2. The applicant has been accepted to a technical school, 2 or 4 year college.
3. The applicant has graduated high school and is not a previous scholarship recipient.
4. Completed applications are due to the Swine Committee/Darke Co. Barrow Boosters by August 1st. Please mail to 1357 State Route 121, New Madison OH 45346.
5. Please include a high school transcript.
6. Please include two letters of recommendations, with at least one being from a 4-H leader, FFA advisor, or a mentor that assisted in helping you with your swine project.
7. After applications are reviewed, a committee may be established to conduct interview with potential scholarship recipients.
8. Number of scholarships and amounts are to be determined.
9. Scholarship recipients will be announced at the Swine awards night at the Darke County Fair.
