- 6. Please include two letters of recommendations, with at least one being from a 4-H leader, FFA advisor, or a mentor that assisted in helping you with your swine project.
- 7. After applications are reviewed, a committee may be established to conduct interview with potential scholarship receipts.
- 8. Number of scholarships and amounts are to be determined.
- 9. Scholarship recipients will be announced at the Swine awards night at the Darke County Fair.
