BEFORE YOU START TO RECORD...



- ☐ Carefully read the exhibit requirements.
- ☐ Get CREATIVE and PLAN your 4-H project judging video.
- ☐ View practice video at <https://youtu.be/qAity49zs-k>.
- ☐ PRACTICE what you're going to say or do during your video.


READY TO RECORD...

- ☐ Click on the customized 4-H project link.
- ☐ Log into the Grid using your email.
- ☐ Click the  to start your video.
- ☐ Click the  to start your recording.
- ☐ Click the arrow to playback. 
- ☐ Watch your video back. Click the **X** if you want to re-record. Otherwise, click the arrow again. 
- ☐ Take a selfie or picture of your 4-H project exhibit as your cover. 
- ☐ Finally, edit your display name (FIRST & LAST NAME) and add a title.
