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### **Parental Consent Form**

Please read and discuss this information with your participant(s). Sign/date this form and give it to your event director and it will be filed with our Camp Administrator.

We (parent/guardian and participant) understand that the Miami County 4-H Clubs Camp, Inc., also known as Indian Hills 4-H Camp or Indian Hills, is a not for profit corporation that is available to renting organizations or individual(s) for their use. Therefore, the management and staff of Indian Hills are not typically overseeing or supervising the camp activities at Indian Hills. The renting organization or individual(s) takes care of running the camp as they see fit, and by contract, are responsible for the individual supervision of anyone who is part of their attending group.

We further understand that any participant(s) at Indian Hills shall be held financially responsible for any damage they intentionally cause to any of Indian Hills' property or goods during their visit or stay at the camp.

We further understand that while under the direction of the renting organization or individual(s), a participant may take part in such things as: canoeing on the camp pond or adjacent river, swimming in the pool, hiking, playing various organized sports or activities during scheduled times or unorganized sports or activities during free times as set up by the renting organization or individual(s). We realize that it is the renting organization or individual(s) who are responsible for making sure a participant is safe and approaches all other attending participants with safety in mind.

#### ***We have discussed the following with our participant:***

- Indian Hills 4-H Camp has rules & regulations that will be shared with ALL participants in order to make sure they have a fun & safe camping experience while at the facility. The participants are responsible for listening & then following directions & exemplify good leadership skills for all other participants.
- Being in & around water, woods, & participation in various camp activities, whether organized or during free time, could cause clothing to become wet, dirty, or damaged beyond cleaning or repair so care & safety needs to be observed at all times.
- Prior to being in a canoe or paddleboat, all participants MUST watch the demonstration provided by the certified lifeguards. Heed all instructions given by camp staff or your own camp staff to avoid any problems, damage, or injury.
- Hiking is to be done only on set trails & NEVER ALONE. Participants must be observant while hiking to avoid any safety issues, such as objects protruding from the ground, tree branches, etc. & ALWAYS report to the camp director prior to setting out on a hike AND upon returning.

- ❑ Taking part in various sporting or recreational events the participant needs to remain alert to avoid any accidents that could cause injury to themselves or other participants.
- ❑ Other participants may act in ways that do not follow your camp rules or our own camping regulations so the participant needs to be aware & avoid any situations that could cause them pain, injury, or getting into trouble.
- ❑ When entering the pool area for the first time, Indian Hills lifeguards will instruct ALL Participants of the rules & regulations of the camp pool. Participants need to be responsible for listening AND following all directions given at this time. Not doing so could result in pain or injury to the participant & other participants, or being asked to leave the pool area, therefore ruining their camping experience.

While at Indian Hills, participants are presented the rules and regulations of Indian Hills 4-H Camp by the staff and are hereby expected to abide by all camp rules and regulations, the most important of which are:

- Participants are expected to listen to & abide by rules and regulations presented by Indian Hills' Staff.
- No one is allowed in the swimming pool area OR swimming in the pool when no lifeguard(s) are present.
- No one may use the canoes or paddleboats without first watching the water safety demonstration AND a camp counselor or adult counselor MUST be present at all times while someone is on the water, and without lifeguards on duty.
- Everyone MUST wear a life jacket, no matter their swimming skills or abilities.
- Shoes/boots (*recommended*) or sandals/flip-flops MUST be worn at all times when walking anywhere around the camp.
- There is to be NO swinging from the cabin rafters & NO jumping on any bunks as this could cause damage OR injury.
- There is to be NO writing or drawing of graffiti anywhere on the camp grounds. There will be a \$25.00 fine for each word.
- ABSOLUTELY no smoking/chewing, alcoholic beverages or illegal drugs are permitted on the camp grounds.
- Over-the-counter OR prescription medications & paperwork are to be given to & handled by the camp nurse ONLY.
- No outside visitors are allowed during the scheduled camp.
- Participants are expected to show respect for Indian Hills & leave the camp better than you found it.

***I have read this document with the participant and have discussed each item with them so that they clearly understand what is expected of them while attending their event at Indian Hills 4-H Camp. I give my permission for them to participate in the activities afforded them at Indian Hills 4-H Camp (any exceptions need to be filed with their event director and/or nurse). I understand that the county 4-H staff and volunteers, OSU Extension and The Ohio State University are not responsible in the event of accidental injury or illness, nor for compounded injury or illness to the Participant's present medical conditions that are listed elsewhere.***
