

ACHIEVEMENT IN 4-H AWARD

Any 4-H member in good standing in the 4-H club is eligible. **Clubs may nominate up to three (3) individuals to receive this award.** The recipient(s) should have demonstrated outstanding achievement over the past year or more while enrolled as a 4-H member. Outstanding advancement in social interaction, communication skills, or overcoming difficult obstacles are examples of reasons to select an individual to receive this award. Recipients may be any age between 8, and in third grade, and 19.

SELECTION PROCESS

It is important that the recipient(s) of this award has shown marked improvement in some area of the 4-H program. With that in mind, it is recommended that the adult leaders select the recipient(s) of this award. This should be a group consensus, with no single individual making the final selection. Individuals may receive this award more than once during their 4-H career.

AWARD NOTIFICATION AND PRESENTATION

All award recipients must be notified by the club. The award recipient(s) and their family should be invited to attend the annual kick-off and recognition program in March. Those being recognized will be presented with an achievement pin and certificate signed by the Extension Educator, 4-H Youth Development, and the Darke County 4-H Committee President.
