Guidelines for Educational Awards

- 1. Money must be used for educational purposes, community service with an educational focus, 4-H promotional activities or recruitment efforts.
- 2. Application must include the signature of the organizational advisor and the 4-H club president.
- 3. Clubs must provide matching dollars in order to be eligible. Any club requesting over \$100.00 must submit a detailed budget (see sample).
- 4. The entire application must be completed in order to be considered.
- 5. Money is not to be used for purchasing awards, parade materials or booth decorations
- 6. Applications will be evaluated by members of the Darke County 4-H Committee.
- 7. Decisions of the evaluating committee are final.
- 8. Clubs receiving funds are required to send a representative to a County 4-H Committee meeting to share how funds were utilized.
- 9. Money is not to be used to purchase materials for projects that will be in 4-H or Jr. Fair competition.
- 10. Clubs may receive this award only once per calendar year.
- 11. Requests for similar items that have already been funded by this award will not be considered.
