

**DARKE COUNTY 4-H FOOD, FASHION AND ARTS BOARD**

- The purpose of the board is to provide events/programming/activities that will strengthen the 4-H Family and Consumer Sciences program.
- The board will consist of up to 15 members. Group will decide on meeting dates and times.
- Members will be expected to act as role models for younger 4-H members and conduct themselves accordingly.
- Members must be at least a freshman in high school. Members of the board must belong to a 4-H club and be enrolled in at least one 4-H Family and Consumer Sciences related project. FCS projects include food and nutrition, clothing, scrapbooking, creative arts, cake decorating, creative writing, quilting, home decorating, child care, and other miscellaneous projects.
- Program year will be from October 1 to September 30.
- Members must attend at least 50% of the meetings in order to be a member in good standing. Anyone who fails to attend the appropriate number of meetings will be dismissed from the board and ineligible to apply for membership the following year.
- Members will be expected to be active participants and help with activities, as needed. These activities may include County 4-H Project Presentation and Evaluation Day and activities during the fair, in addition to other activities as determined by the membership.
