

LEADERSHIP IN 4-H AWARD

Any 4-H member in good standing and who has been an active participant in club activities can be nominated for this award. **Clubs may nominate up to three (3) individuals to receive this award.** Those receiving this recognition should have demonstrated outstanding leadership qualities through their work as a club officer, youth leader, committee chair, activity coordinator, or other club functions. It is not a requirement for award recipients to have held any of the previously listed offices or chair positions. Recipients may be any age between 8, and in third grade, and 19.

SELECTION PROCESS

Selection of the award recipient(s) is to be done in one of the two following manners:

1. All members and volunteers vote by secret ballot to determine the award recipient(s).
2. Vote by all volunteers to determine the award recipient(s).
3. Individuals may receive this award more than once during their 4-H career.

AWARD NOTIFICATION AND PRESENTATION

All award recipients must be notified by the club. The award recipient(s) and their family should be invited to attend the annual kick-off and recognition program in March. Those being recognized will be presented with leadership pin and certificate signed by the Extension Educator, 4-H Youth Development, and the Darke County 4-H Committee President.
