

Darke County 4-H Camp Parent/Guardian Checklist

One Week Before Camp:

- Go through your child's wardrobe/belongings and make sure they have all the items needed for camp.
- Label belongings that will be making the trip to camp with your child's name.
- Help your child begin packing for camp. Starting early helps your child to feel prepared and helps you avoid the stress of packing at the last minute. Involve your child in the packing process so they know exactly what has been packed.
- Prepare prescription medications. Medications must be in the original container. Include only what is needed for the duration of camp. Put your child's medication in a ziplock plastic bag and label with your child's name.
- Look up directions to camp. Plan to arrive at camp **no earlier than 6:30pm on June 17.**
 - Camp address is 8212 W. Lauer Road, Pleasant Hill

One Day Before Camp:

- If someone other than a parent/guardian will be bringing your child to camp, complete the bottom section of the restricted release form and send it to camp with your child.
- Check the weather for camp and make sure your child has appropriate clothing and outerwear.

Camp Check In:

- Please leave your pets at home.**
- Check in at the registration table. Bring any medication (prescription and over-the-counter), properly labeled with your child's name.
- After you have completed checking in, help your child take their luggage to their cabin.
 - Meet your child's counselors. Ask them any questions you may have.

Camp Check Out:

- Plan to arrive no earlier than 4:00pm on June 20.
- Check in at the table in front of the lodge to pick up your child's medication.
 - Check the lost and found for any of your child's belongings.
- Do not go directly to your child's cabin and begin removing their luggage.
- You **MUST** sign your child out with your camper's counselor before leaving camp.
