CATS AND GUINEA PIGS will be judged at Project Presentation Day only if the member is not taking the animal to the fair. **NO LIVE ANIMALS ARE TO BE BROUGHT TO PROJECT PRESENTATION DAY.**

SELF DETERMINED PROJECTS – If project is in an advanced area of woodworking, photography, or electricity, go to the judge in those respective areas. All other self-determined projects go to the Self-Determined Judge.

REVUE TIMES – Check the fair book for tentative revue times. For final times, check the revue listings posted in the Youth Building. Revues may be combined or shifted depending on number of participants. Revue Cards are due to the Senior Fair board Office by August 1.

JUDGING RESULTS - Winners will be recognized at All Seasons Place on Thursday, July 18, beginning at 7:00pm. Results will be posted to our website <http://darke.osu.edu/program-areas/4-h-youth-development> no earlier than noon on Wednesday, July 17.

Please do not call our office prior to that time to find out the results. Due to the short turn-around time, we will not be notifying the winners directly.
